Executive Director Report

Executive Director Ervin mentioned to the board the possibility of additional funding from the American Rescue Plan. Executive Director Ervin mentioned, if the funding occurred, it could potentially modify the budget or even double the budget.

Board Member Comments:

Commissioner Keyes reported that Pines Elementary school is closing due to air quality concerns.

Commissioner Pugh reported a rise in COVID cases but stated the county was still in good shape. Commissioner Pugh also spoke about the ferry services.

Commissioner Fondella Leigh mentioned Perquimans County was working on their budget.

At-Large Delegate Elizabeth Hedrick discussed broadband issues in Gates County.

Commissioner Davis reported that students have returned to in school learning, COVID cases are low, Tyrell County is in the budget process, and the prison is still operating at minimal capacity.

Commissioner Kirby reported the current Town Manager of Edenton is retiring in September.

Commissioner Etheridge reported COVID cases have stabilized. Commissioner Etheridge also discussed possibly expanding two schools and building a new elementary school.

At-Large Delegate Hoggard reported downtown Elizabeth City is becoming more active.

Commissioner Linda Hofler reported Gates County hired a new County Manager, Tim Wilson.

Chairperson Griffin mentioned meeting with an Elizabeth City State University (ECSU) representative to try to put together a status of this region. Chairperson Griffin discussed letter of support for I87. Chairperson Griffin mentioned the NC Promise opportunity offered through ECSU.
