Commissioner Kirby mentioned several projects in Chowan County including the upcoming Recreation Bond referendum vote, the construction of the high school, broadband, and windmills in the county.

Commissioner Tiffney White gave an update on Camden County's EMS production, along with other upcoming events in the county, such as, Camden Heritage Festival, Dismal Day, and the FIRE department's Open House.

Chairperson Davis discussed the soft opening of the new Royal Farms in Tyrrell County and an upcoming four-wheel rally for the Fire Department.
