The North Carolina Department of Transportation has allocated Federal SPR (State Planning and Research) funds as detailed in the table below:

The funds are available on a reimbursable basis according to an 80/5/15 cost share and are expected to be matched by a minimum of 5% local funds.

Reimbursement for planning expenses should be made through the invoice submittal procedure as outlined by the RPO Administrative Procedures. Reimbursements will only be made for transportation planning expenses incurred in executing the work tasks described in your approved FY 2026 PWP, which is due by May 16, 2025.

Draft FY 2025-2026 Planning Work Program

Summary

The Planning Work Program (PWP) is a funding contract between the Albemarle Rural Planning Organization (ARPO) and the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT). The Plan lists planning priorities anticipated by the ARPO during the next fiscal year, and outlines expenses needed for certain work tasks. The PWP is reviewed, and approved by the ARPO Rural Technical Coordinating Committee (RTCC), Rural Transportation Advisory Committee (RTAC), and the NCDOT Transportation Planning Division. Revisions to the PWP are allowed if the ARPO needs to make significant changes to the overall budget or a specific work task, however, no additional dues will be requested from County members. An approved PWP is required for the Lead Planning Agency, the Albemarle Commission, to be reimbursed for work task expenses incurred by the ARPO.

I. Data Collection and Assessment

For FY 2026, ARPO staff will continue to monitor compliance with the Title VI program, and will maintain socioeconomic and demographic data for member counties. ARPO staff will also continue to collect AADT data throughout the region for traffic volume mapping. Additionally, ARPO staff will collect and assess highway and non-highway data for use in developing the ARPO's Prioritization 8.0 project submittal list, and the identification of potential safety projects.

II. Transportation Planning

Comprehensive Transportation Plans (CTPs) have been drafted and adopted for all ten counties within ARPO. Funding has been included in this category for the development of the Camden-Currituck-Pasquotank Regional CTP.

ARPO staff will review the final results of Prioritization 7.0. Staff will work with RTCC & RTAC members, local governments, airports, transit agencies, the NCDOT Ferry Division, and NCDOT Division 1 on the development of ARPO's Prioritization 8.0 project submittals. Once the ARPO's project submittal list is adopted by the RTCC & RTAC, staff will submit each project into NCDOT's SPOT Online software. Staff will review the ARPO's Local Input Point Assignment Methodology for Prioritization 7.0, and will coordinate with RTCC & RTAC members on any potential changes to the methodology for Prioritization 8.0. Depending on the final schedule for Prioritization 8.0, staff may begin working with RTCC & RTAC members on Local Input Point Assignments for ARPO projects competing in the Regional Impact category in Prioritization 8.0.

ARPO staff will review the 2026-2035 State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) with Division 1 and report out STIP funded projects to the RTCC and RTAC. ARPO Staff will also attend required merger team meetings and any local government and/or public meeting for projects in the merger process. Merger is a process to streamline the project development and permitting processes. Stakeholders include the NCDOT, USACE, NCDENR (DWQ, DCM), and FHWA. The Merger process provides a forum for appropriate agency representatives to discuss and reach consensus on ways to facilitate meeting the regulatory requirements of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act during the NEPA/SEPA decision-making phase of transportation projects.

The ARPO Coordinator is a member of the North Carolina Association of Rural Planning Organizations (NCARPO). The Coordinator serves on the Administrative Documents Committee, and as the MPO Liaison, the Emerging Technologies Liaison, and Legislative Liaison. ARPO staff will continue to provide updates to the RTCC and RTAC on transportation-related legislation, and will continue to attend and report on the following: Highway 17/64 Association meetings, Southern Albemarle Association meetings, NCARPO quarterly meetings and committee meetings, ICPTA Board meetings, and the NCAMPO annual conference.

III. Administration of Transportation Planning and Policies

As a requirement of funding, the ARPO Director will prepare the PWP for FY 24-25, prepare quarterly invoice and progress reports for FY 24-25, coordinate RTAC Ethics requirements, update the ARPO Facebook page and web page on a regular basis, prepare and distribute meeting agendas, draft meeting minutes, and continue to respond to member requests. The ARPO Director will also continue to work with the State Ethics office regarding RTAC member Ethics forms, and provide weekly updates regarding transportation related news in our region.

IV. Direct Costs

These are regular costs for administration of the RPO program not covered in Indirect costs. These include, computer equipment, printer cartridges, printers, and other office supplies not covered under Indirect charges. Direct costs also include advertising, mileage, hotel, and meal costs and registration and training costs for the RPO Director.

V. Indirect Costs

These costs include a portion of the Albemarle Commission staff salaries, workman's compensation, unemployment insurance, contracted services for IT, finance, and legal, general office supplies, rent for facilities, meeting room equipment, and staff development programs.

Region 17 Travel Demand Model

The finalized Region 17 Travel Demand Model (TDM), covering 10 Counties in the Albemarle RPO region, is now available for use in traffic studies and impact analyses.

This advanced model supports the estimation of Average Weekday Daily Traffic (AWDT) for April/September weekdays, simulates peak travel conditions for a summer weekend (July Saturday), and includes a customized visitor trip model. Additionally, it incorporates features for analyzing Connected Autonomous Vehicles (CAVs), making it a versatile tool for transportation planning and analysis.

Regional Comprehensive Transportation Plan (CTP) Development for Pasquotank, Camden, and Currituck Counties

The NCDOT Transportation Planning Division (TPD) is developing Comprehensive Transportation Plans (CTPs) as part of North Carolina's multi-modal transportation planning efforts. A CTP is a collaborative, community-driven process to identify future transportation system needs, accommodating anticipated growth and development. It includes highways, public transportation, rail, and bicycle/pedestrian facilities to address future travel demand.

Key features of a CTP include:

- **Community Consensus:** Establishes agreement on transportation needs to support growth and development.
- **Multi-Modal Approach:** Identifies improvements for highways, transit, rail, and bicycle facilities.
- **Integrated Planning:** Strengthens connections between transportation, local land development plans, and community visions.
- **Adoption Status:** Represents a mutually adopted agreement between the state and the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO). Once adopted by NCDOT, it reflects the state's concurrence with locally identified needs.

A CTP is more environmentally and community-friendly than traditional transportation plans and will ultimately replace the MPO's existing Thoroughfare Plan.

TPD Costal Planning Group is excited to announce plans to develop a regional CTP for **Pasquotank, Camden, and Currituck Counties** in the Albemarle RPO region. This effort will ensure transportation planning aligns with the unique needs and visions of our communities.

We encourage all Albemarle RPO committee members to engage in this process and stay informed about upcoming milestones.

2026-2035 STIP Development

The N.C. Department of Transportation's long-range transportation plan – called the State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) – identifies the construction funding and schedule for state transportation projects over a 10-year period. NCDOT updates the STIP approximately every two years. The data-driven process to update the STIP is called [Strategic Prioritization](#). The current cycle to update the STIP for the years 2026-2035 is called Prioritization 7.0 or P7.0.

It will start in summer 2023 when NCDOT divisions and local planning organizations gather initial public input on projects, which will then be submitted for evaluation and scoring. By Summer 2025, NC BOT will adopt 2026-2035 STIP. In addition, 2024-2033 STIP Map adopted already is available [here](#).

- Staff from the Mid-East Commission Council of Governments will be assisting with the administration of the Albemarle RPO during its staffing transition period.
 - Originally scheduled to be released this month, the draft 2026-2035 STIP is now expected to be released in February. The final 2026-2035 STIP is scheduled to be approved by the Board of Transportation at their July 2025 meeting. The new STIP will consist of projects submitted by MPOs, RPOs, and Highway Divisions across the State in Prioritization 7.0.
 - The project submittal phase for Prioritization 8.0 is currently scheduled to begin in July, and end in September. ARPO Staff has started reviewing previous prioritization submittals, and CTP recommendations for all 10 Counties in the region. ARPO staff will soon begin to set up individual meetings with each County to discuss Prioritization 8.0 project submittals.
 - Applications for grants through the Governor's Highway Safety Program are open until January 31, 2025.
 - Applications for free bicycle helmets through the NCDOT Integrated Mobility Division are open until February 14, 2025.

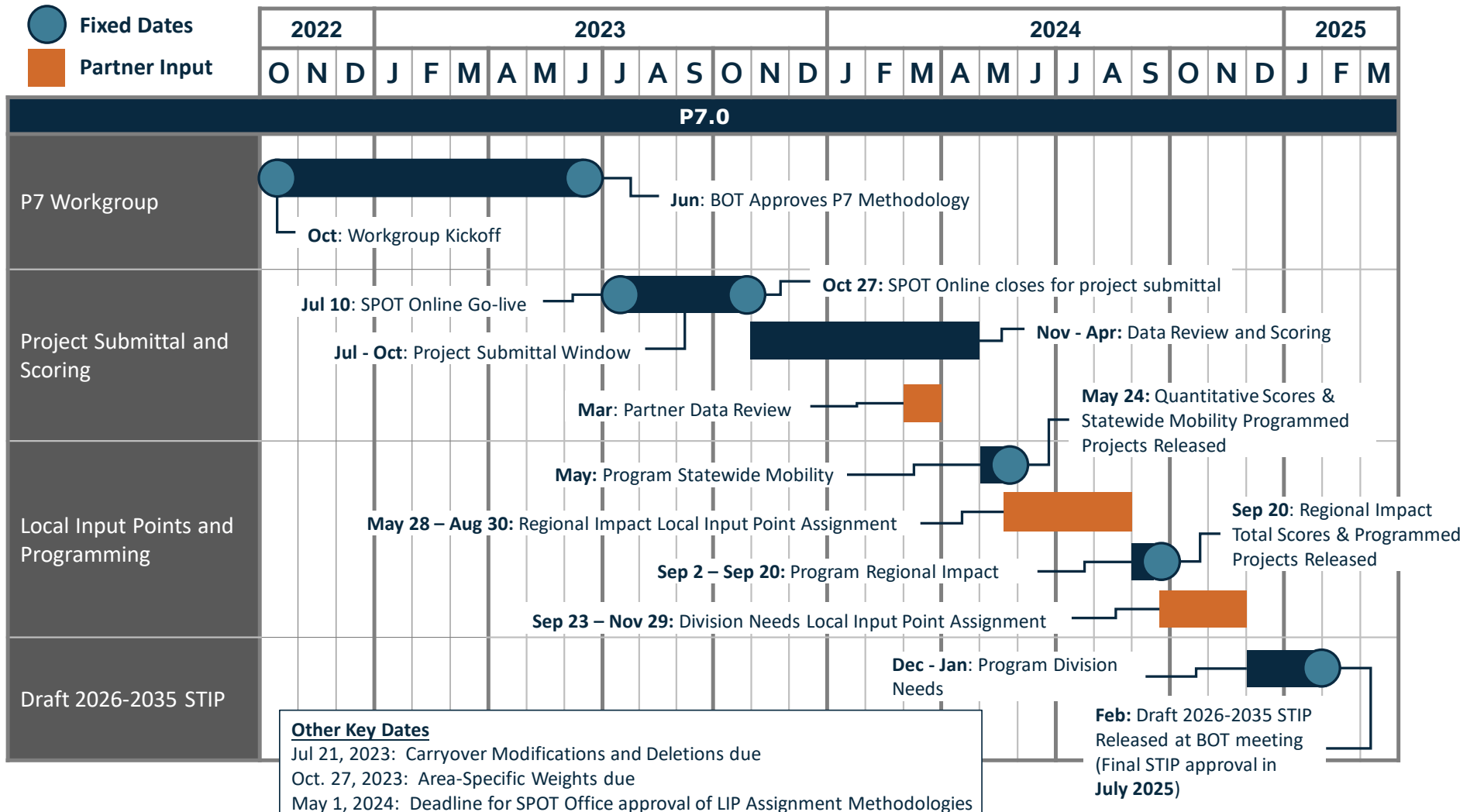

Governor's Highway Safety Program Grant Applications Open Through Jan. 31

RALEIGH – The [North Carolina Governor's Safety Program](#) is now accepting grant applications for initiatives addressing traffic safety.

The selected grantees will use this money to fund projects that occur during the 2026 federal fiscal year, Oct. 1, 2025-Sep. 30, 2026.

“This funding plays a vital role in making North Carolina roads safer for everyone,” said GHSP Director Mark Ezzell. “These grants empower communities at the local level to act, improve awareness and implement programs that help prevent traffic crash injuries and fatalities.”

Past applicants include law enforcement agencies, local and state governments, hospitals, public health agencies, educational organizations, emergency medical services and nonprofits.

Last year, GHSP awarded more than \$22 million in community-based grants intended to reduce traffic crashes, injuries and fatalities on N.C. roads.

Bicycle Helmet Initiative

In an effort to keep kids safe while riding a bicycle, the Bicycle Helmet Initiative program distributes helmets to children of low-income families, and is open to both government and non-government agencies.

Overview & Guidelines – 2025 Application Cycle

Description

Bicycle safety and education is an integral part of the Integrated Mobility Division's purpose. To promote bicycle safety, which includes helmet usage, the Bicycle Helmet Initiative selection process awards helmets to eligible government and nonprofit agencies. Helmets will be awarded and distributed once per calendar year in the spring and awardees will have the remainder of the calendar year to host their program. Selected applicants meeting the criteria will be awarded helmets to distribute to low income children. The applicants must file a report about the distribution event within 30 days after the event occurs or at the end of the year (see timeline below).

Goal

The primary goal of the Bicycle Helmet Initiative is to reduce child/youth bicycle fatalities and serious injuries, including head trauma, in North Carolina.

Funding

Funding for the Bicycle Helmet Initiative is made possible through the "Share the Road"

Persons dedicated to bicycle safety in North Carolina have continued to support this initiative and have made thousands of helmets available to children.

Helmets

Applicants have the option of requesting 25, 50, 75, or 100 helmets in the application. The more helmets that are requested, the stronger the application must be in describing the event and benefit to the community. Therefore, we recommend applicants request an amount they are certain can be distributed at the planned event. The helmets will come in a variety of sizes designed to fit children and youth unless specified on the application.

Additional Guidelines

Applicants are encouraged to partner with groups in the community to extend the outreach of bicycle safety awareness. Examples of partners include police/fire departments, parks and recreation departments, health departments, community centers, churches and non-governmental groups.

Applicants must provide contact information for the person who will be overseeing the bicycle safety program where helmets will be distributed. All questions on the application must be completed within the space provided.

The awards committee will work to create equitable distribution of helmets across the state by considering geography, the number of helmets requested, and the size of the municipality or applying entity.

To be considered for the Bicycle Helmet Initiative Award, the application is to be filled out completely and submitted by the application deadline of **February 14, 2025**. The Integrated Mobility Division reserves the right to increase or decrease the amount of helmets awarded to each applicant based on the availability of funds.

Applicants are required to specify a valid *physical commercial* shipping address on the application (**PO Boxes are not acceptable. Residential addresses are not acceptable**). The helmet supplier has strict shipping policies and screens all addresses before shipping. Delivery addresses which do not meet these criteria will not ship and will cause significant delays in helmet delivery. Please note that in the event of an award, helmets will go to the qualified address and the applicant is responsible for ensuring that someone can receive them.

Criteria/Requirements for Applying

- Applicants/Organizations must be located within North Carolina and activities must take place in North Carolina.
- Applicants must be government entities or nonprofit organizations.
- Helmets should be distributed to low income children 17 & under.
- Bicycle safety programs should consider ways to identify and invite children in the community who would benefit most from receiving a helmet through this initiative.
- Bicycle helmet distribution is intended to coincide with a bicycle safety education program.
- Helmets cannot be received for personal need.
- Helmets cannot be sold.
- Helmet distribution must take place within the awarding calendar year unless otherwise granted approval.
- Awardees will submit a report on their bicycle program within 30 days following event (Final deadline for report/ status update is December 31, 2024).
