URGENT REPAIR PROGRAM WASHINGTON COUNTY

At 71 years old, Linda Spruill lives alone and is on a very limited income. The Washington County home that she resides in is over 60 years old. Recently, Ms. Spruill had a roof installed by a contractor that did not complete the job, causing leaks and severe damage to the kitchen and laundry room ceilings. Ms. Spruill's handicapped ramp was rotted and very dangerous to use. Additionally, the back steps and back door had rotted and deteriorated, making them inoperable and unsafe to use.

The Albemarle Commission Community Development Program was able to assist Ms. Spruill by fixing the leaks in her roof, repairing her back door, replacing her back steps and rebuilding her handicapped ramp. Ms. Spruill can now enter and exit her home safely through both doors and no longer has to worry about her ceilings collapsing. Ms. Spruill says that she is "delighted" with the work and praised the contractors for their professionalism and quality of work.
